<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	<div>1. Structure and English is very weak. Many sentences do not have even full stop or period at the end. We do not see good paragraphs in the article. In many occasions (e.g., in two portions of <b>TB SCENARIO GLOBALLY</b> and <b>TUBERCULOSIS DETECTION FOR CHEST X-RAYS OF A HIGHLY TUBERCULOSIS ENVIRONMENTS FOR DETERMINING TREATMENT ORDER</b>) the whole paragraph consists of only one sentence.</div> <div>2. No reference for Figure 1.</div> <div>3. Eight “symptoms of active tuberculosis” have been explained, but we don’t know where have they come from.</div> <div>4. Most of the introduction data have been taken from “WebMD”.</div> <div>5. “TB SCENARIO GLOBALLY” part consists of 332 words, but it has only one reference.</div> <div>6. “<b>TESTS AND DIAGNOSIS OF TB</b>” part of the review consists of 209 words, but has only one reference.</div> <div>7. “<b>TUBERCULOSIS DETECTION FOR CHEST X-RAYS OF A HIGHLY TUBERCULOSIS ENVIRONMENTS FOR DETERMINING TREATMENT ORDER</b>” part of the review contains 443 words, but only one reference at the end.</div> <div>8. Referencing style is very poor. Many references cannot be found, are without any link, or without proper information, such as following references:</div> <div>1. Adewole O.
