Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The study sought to associate the appearance of septic arthritis by <i>Sphingomonas Paucimobilis</i> due to a previous infection by Covid. As, from the study, it is not possible to prove a direct relationship between the two diseases mentioned, I suggest that the authors make it very clear to readers that there is a possibility that the cause of septic arthritis by <i>Sphingomonas Paucimobilis</i> is not directly related to the previous Covid infection.</p> <p>I also suggest putting a more specific title. For example: <i>Sphingomonas Paucimobilis</i> septic arthritis post Covid - Case Report</p> <p>Even though it is not the focus of the study, I suggest putting more information about the protocol used in the treatment of <i>Sphingomonas Paucomobilis</i> septic arthritis with ciprofloxacin, as well as in the treatment of Covid with steroids.</p> <p>References also need to be standardized.</p>
