This is important presentation and complication of COVID-19 that might happen in any stage of the disease, and in this case in very early phase. The article should undergo revision (generally minor issues) to reach strong and compelling presentation that might be suggested for publication.	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>In the abstract please shorten the first part and add lab, ECG and imaging data in the second that will point out more closely to diagnosis of myocarditis.</p> <p>In the case presentation, please</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Delete the sentence: <i>This entire list of examinations was unclear without any background information or new investigations</i></li> <li>- Please add reference values in lab findings</li> <li>- Please describe ECG findings of mild ST elevation</li> <li>- Please delete the part of the sentence and rephrase... <i>it was decided that a cardiac bed should be ordered for the patient</i></li> <li>- Please delete or rephrase the sentence... <i>The patient was made to complete his course for COVID19 as well</i></li> <li>- it is not clear when and why the patient was intubated, as the authors only mention extubation on day 7</li> <li>- the working diagnosis seems to be fulminant myocarditis with severe heart failure; so the differential diagnosis presented in the Case should be transferred and discussed in the Discussion section</li> <li>- no data on anticoagulation</li> <li>- lab data upon recovery should be included... probably best in the table with initial and final results</li> <li>- the same refers to CT findings</li> <li>- please add the list of drugs on the discharge from the hospital</li> </ul>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The article is well written and fluent but needs final English language expert revision. For example, there are some non-academic expressions that should be omitted... <i>Cases of COVID19-associate myocarditis were being heard from here and there....</i> This Case can be accepted for publication with minor revision.
