Compulsory REVISION comments	1. Reduced and split liver transplant – differences not clearly explained 2. The Liver transplant in the recipient is not explained (artery, vein and duct anastomosis) 3. Dose, indication, monitoring, regime / protocol of medications not included 4. Type of monitoring / review in the post-operative period is not outlined 5. The conclusion is not reflecting the discussion in the manuscript	
Minor REVISION comments	1. Use of figures (Fig1, 2) without giving credit to the primary author is plagiarism. Hepatocellular ca is more common in adults and is an uncommon indication of pediatric liver transplant. The relevance of the figures in the manuscript is unclear 2. References not correctly cited. The contraindications in pg 3 are cited to ref no 4 which is not relevant
