Minor REVISION comments	The results are presented mainly by tables and figures. There is no text where the fig.and tabl. to be mentioned. Some of the tables are unnecessary. The content of tables 2 and 3 can be given in the text. Table 4 and Figure 2 show the same information, the same goes for Table 8 and Figure 3. In the "Discussion" section there are 8 citations missing in "Bibliography". The mention should contain the name and et. al. The conclusion should not repeat the results.
