<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	In the whole manuscript, before the first time mentioned abbreviation, the expanded version should be stated. For instance, before ARDS, Adult Respiratory Distress Syndrome should be written. Names of bacteria should be written as follow: <i>Mycobacterium tuberculosis</i> , <i>Klebsiella pneumonia</i> , <i>Staphiloccocus epidermidis</i> etc. In the Figure 4 authors should add arrows to depict enlarged mediastinal lymph nodes with metabolic activity. In the Case report section, at the end of the fifth sentence, number of table (Table 1.) should be added. The authors should explain which pulmonary X-ray characteristics were suggestive of ARDS (Case report, the end of the fourth sentence- Fig. 1).	
<b><u>Minor</u></b> REVISION comments	My suggestion to authors is to create a list of abbreviations after Key words, which will make reading and understanding much easier to readers, especially, who is not an expert in the field.
