<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>The reference n. 1 should be replaced with a more recent one, such as (doi: 10.3322/caac.21492).</p> <p>Keywords: Apopstosis should be written with A in capital letter.</p> <p>Introduction section: In the sentence "There were 13.8 lac new cancer cases", lac need a "k" at the end.</p> <p>Please, use "HER +" and not "HER + ive" or "HER -+ive" because is ambiguous sometimes. The same for negative.</p> <p>Please, edit "+ive" with positive or use the "+" symbol alone. The same for negative.</p> <p>Please, pay attention to capital and small letters, such as Her2, wnt that should be written always in the same way (HER2, Wnt).</p> <p>At the end of "Wnt signaling" section, the sentence "A, Wnt1/3 binds the G-protein coupled receptor Fzd ..... preventing the translation of qualities that promote metastasis and attack. [111].", looks like a figure legend. On this regard, since I suppose it is a part of the main text, do not begin the sentence with A.</p> <p>Figure 1: All tumour should be replaced with "Breast cancer".</p> <p>Figures' legends in general should have the same font (bold, regular).</p> <p>Figure 6: After the dot, please use capital letter (such as "Canonical").</p>
