| <b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments | <p>This is an intriguing study, as the authors have amassed a unique dataset in order to predict and write concisely. The chapter is well-written and structured in general. However, the paper, in my opinion, has certain shortcomings in terms of data analysis and writing. Below, I have made various comments on the text, which is frequently ambiguous and long-winded. Additionally, I proposed citing more recent and pertinent material in some situations. Additionally, I gave other recommendations for conducting more in-depth studies of the data.</p> <p><b>Comment 1:</b> The manuscript needs a lot of work in terms of language and grammar. The entire document is filled with typos and grammatical errors that can't be overlooked, making the chapter difficult to comprehend. Several errors have been highlighted in the paragraph below, for reference:</p> <p>With the expansion of facilities of travel and occupation, man has to undertake extensive journeys, through diverse modes such as rail, road, water etc. The change in the social fabric has also urged <b>the</b> female population to undertake <b>the</b> strenuous and prolonged journey. <b>The patterns and modes of working have also undergone significant changes due to mechanization, leading to sedentary occupational patterns.</b> Most of these situations cited have been principally implicated in vaigunya of Apanavayu. In classics, Atiyana is said to be the cause of many diseases. Even though the term Atiyana is not used in many of them, terms <b>that</b> resemble Atiyana were used. They are as follows atichamkramana, adhwa (excessive travel), margatikarsanath, sahasam (straiful work), aayasam, yanayana (long distance travel), hayaotra yana (travel on elephanats, horses, etc.), <b>etc.</b> Atiyana is regarded as one of the prime <b>causes of</b> the following diseases. Vatavyadi, vatajagulma, vatajakasa, kshatajkasa, swasa, rajayekshma etc. Atiyana produces several physical and mental stress. In <b>the</b> long run these physical and mental stress give way <b>to</b> severe musculoskeletal problems leading to loss of working hours due to ill health, <b>thereby</b> leading to loss of productivity to the nation. It is the right time to concentrate this issue from the concepts of Ayurveda, Apana vayu vaigunya and athiyana. Based on these observations, <b>the present study aims</b> to explore the hidden concept of Apana vaigunya mentioned in Ayurvedic literature in relation <b>to</b> atiyana.</p> <p><b>Comment 2:</b> "With the expansion of facilities of travel and occupation, man has to undertake extensive journeys, through diverse modes such as rail, road, water etc." Please consider rephrasing these sentences with more detail and citation.</p> <p><b>Comment 3:</b> As the manuscript based on Ayurveda, so it has many sanskrit/hindi terminology. Author are requested to either explain these terminology or at least italicized it in whole manuscript to avoid confusion among international readers.</p> <p><b>Comment 4:</b> "Among Tridoshas, Vata dosa has more importance for the physiological and pathological state of the body due to its gunas and karmas". Please cite more references for the data.</p> <p><b>Comment 5:</b> "Since the stana of apana vayau is the important site of vata dosa, through the treatment of apana vayu all the other subtypes of vata can also be managed." Kindly be more detailed and perhaps you can add other details to this by citing more references.</p> |   |
