	REVIEW REPORT Thank you for the invitation to review the manuscript " Study about Psychodermatology	
	and Its Therapeutic Effects"	
	The article aimed to "determine if psychological stress has any role to play in onset or	
	progression of skin related diseases or disorders". To achive this goal, the authors	
	performed a systematic search on Pubmed, Google Scholar, MedLine, as well as some	
	"manual searches".	
	As the main result of the study the authors reported that "some prevalent skin disorders caused due to psychological stresses are: dermatitis artefacta, skin hypochondriasis, acne, eczema, psoriasis" The conclusion of the study was: "Psychological stress has been linked to the worsening of certain skin conditions." Highlighting that there are important neuroimunological findings in skin diseases.	
	Before expressing my opinion on the opportunity of publishing this study, I would like to	
	make a few comments regarding the manuscript content.	
	1. Title: Study about Psychodermatology and Its Therapeutic Effects - it is too general	
	and at the same time not clear enough and not well related to the content of the	
	manuscript.	
	2. There are major inconsistencies between Title and Aim (as expressed in the	
	paper's abstract)	
	3. In Abstract, the conclusions have been presented before the results.	
	 Inside the Manuscript the informations are organised in 5 main sections : 1. Introduction, 2. Psychodermatology of Specific Disorders, 3. Classification of Psychodermatosis, 4. Therapeutic Considerations, and 5. Result. 	
	I suggest the construction of a Methodology section in which to describe in detail the steps taken in search of the articles considered in this study, the search criteria, as well as the inclusion and the exclusion criteria. This section should be accompanied by a table or more summarizing the articles included in the study.	
	Regarding to this internal structure of the article it is not clear if the sections 2, 3, 4 are independent, or belong to the section 1 (Introduction), or may be subsections of an unspecified part (e.g. Theorethical findings).	
	5. There are essential sections that are completely missing: Methodology, Discussions and Conclusions.

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	 The informations in the manuscript section have been presented without being accompanied by sufficient citations of references. The sentences are unclear and confusing in many places. 	
	7. Last but not least, the purpose of this study was to "determine if psychological stress has any role to play in onset or progression of skin related diseases or disorders". I suggest that the expression and wording of the goal to be reviewed and eventually to find a new wording that covers the already obvious evidence of the link between some skin diseases and stress.
