Some readers don't know what are you referring to and authors must provide to reference to understand text.- Text format must be reviewed- There are no references to statistical methods employed in analysis and the analysis is poor. Variables are not well defined.- Types of implants, location of the fracture (discussion is not the place to talk about your results) ... more details must be provided on text about fractures and treatment.- Kyphotic angles are included in discussion and not in results, section were have to be included.
