<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	1. There are many sections using the same text (like internal plagiarism): the reviewer has highlighted in the original manuscript to show that there are many pairs of long texts in different part of the document (see the comments in the attached manuscript). The highlights with the same color are the repeated texts showing 2 times in the same document, or in other word, it should not be cut & pasted in the single manuscript. Revision of text is required to avoid using the same text again and again. 2. Many names of persons or organizations (like WHO) cited in the text are not shown in the reference list.	
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	The author use different term of the disease: Covid-19, covid-19, covid, COVID-19, Covid 19, COVID19, COVID, and COVID 19. The term COVID is an acronym from “coronavirus disease”, thus it is not correct to use “Covid” or “covid”; and there should be uniform use or not use of hyphen: either “COVID-19” or “COVID 19” in the same document.	
<u>Optional/General</u> comments	The writing style is not smooth.
