Abstract "Acanthamoeba keratitis; Keratitis that's caused by the minute parasite acanthamoeba can be difficult to luxury. Antibiotic eye drops are used". Antibiotics are not the specific treatment for Acanthameba, please write the specific treatment.- Page 1. Key words "vericonazole, posaconaole." Please correct.- Page 1 . Introduction "ciliary bullying". Please replace by Ciliary injection.- Page 2 "Biological records cannot penetrate". What is the meaning of biological records?- Page 2 "It is emphasized that there is (2)." The sentence is not complete.- Page 2, Etiology "There are many possible causes for keratitis, a condition of the eye that causes the cornea to become inflamed. Different types of infections," This part could be risk factors and remove the 1st two sentences.- Page 4, Differential diagnosis. "(a surgeon who specializes in diseases and surgery of the eye)". No need to define ophthalmologist.- Page 13, Conclusion. " IK ". Is not a known abbreviation to infectious keratitis and also AMR is not a common abbreviation to be used.
