Therefore, you must add the research background (explicitly) in the Abstract subsection. Please complete it.</p> <p>(c) There are two kinds of online learning: synchronous and asynchronous online. Please make sure in your article whether you mean synchronous online or asynchronous online. Please complete it. Consider completing it.</p> <p>(b) (b) You have written the same word with and without a hyphen (online and on-line) in your document. Both ways are acceptable, but it's best to be consistent</p> <p><b>In the Material and Method subsection</b></p> <p>(a) In this Material and Method subsection, it should be stated that the population or sample of research data is 294 students. It is also necessary to explain the 294 data as sample data or class population. If the data is sampled, it must indicate the sampling technique used.</p> <p>(b) There should be an explanation of the type of 10 questions conducted in research for assessing students' perceptions regarding the difficulty of online teaching whether in the form of essay questions, multiple choice or other.</p> <p>(c) It is not clear what you mean in each question to the students by the words: UNDERSTANDING, ....., INTERACTION at the end of each question. Should be removed because the meaning is confusing.</p> <p><b>In the Conclusion subsection</b></p> <p>Please revise or improve the description in the conclusion subsection. Thank you</p>	
	<p><b>In the subtitle of References</b></p> <p>The number of references cited in your manuscript is insufficient. Please add the number of references from the latest scientific articles. The total cited articles reach a minimum of 15 articles and even better if it reaches more than 20 articles.</p>
